

FROM THE DESK OF FR. ALFONSE...

While meditating on today's Gospel, I discovered something that I had never noticed before. The Lord compares himself to a thief: "If the master of the house had known the hour of night when the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake." Why a thief? Why not a King? That is: "if the master of the house had known the hour of night when the King was coming, he would have stayed awake and prepared a meal, a bed for his guest."

There are four ways to pass a test: You can (1) study hard and not question it; (2) cheat; or (3) hope the professor changes the grades; (4) or hope the passing grade is significantly lowered. Likewise, there are four ways to live life with God: You can (1) strive for it; (2) try to slide into it; (3) hope and pray that the Lord changes the rules; (4) hope and pray that the Lord significantly widens the gates of heaven.

The Lord is a thief! He is! Little by little, He takes away the most important things in our life. Most of the time, He follows a certain pattern. When we are young, He takes away our grandparents, then our parents, and then, slowly but surely, He begins to work on us. Little by little, the Lord slides the carpet out from under us. He takes from us our wealth and our health. And then, when we are at our weakest moment, He takes our spouse away from us. Only in death do we part.

Why is He a thief? Well, how else will I come to realize that He, and only He, is at the end of the tunnel; that He is the beginning and the end; the only thing that matters? What I may not realize is that the Lord is actually blessing me. He is actually helping me, helping me to live up to the prayers I say to Him. For years, I have prayed the Creed. Do I believe in

Him? He will help me to find out. Or maybe I have never prayed the Creed. Do I believe just in myself? He will help me to find out!

Every day I proclaim to the world that I love the Lord and that I believe in Him. Now do I trust in Him? Am I ready to place my life in His Hands? Life is all about realizing one's prayers

of holiness. Like John the Baptist, will I not be truly blessed when I can unconditionally, unequivocally, accept God's divine Will and live up to my own prayer: "He must increase, I must decrease"? John prayed that his "little light" would be blown out. Did he really mean it? Would he go through with it? The Lord answered his prayer for holiness, and the Baptist lived up to it and was blessed. Now, it is time for us to do the same.

There are plenty who try to cheat their way in life and into heaven. They are similar to those who spend beyond their means, or try to show that a

sinner's life is really the best life E-V-E-R! Like all those who have gone before them, they will write in their autobiography how they wish they could do it all over again, but without the sinning part.

"Stay awake in the hour of the night!" means discover God in the darkness of the world. "Stay awake" means open your eyes; change your mentality; stop seeking external and visible signs to reinforce your own perception of God's Will for you.

"We will know God to the extent that we are set free from ourselves." (Pope Benedict XVI)







MINISTRY SPOTLIGHT

Pastoral Advisory Council (PAC)

The Pastoral Advisory Council (PAC) works directly with the Pastor to promote the spiritual growth of the parish community and to plan ways for the parish life to carry out the mission of the church. It represents the interests and pastoral needs of the entire parish.

"This pastoral council possesses a consultative vote only and is governed by norms determined by the diocesan bishop." (Canon 536, par. 2)

PAC began the year with a retreat in which the members, with Fr. Alfonse's

guidance, considered and defined its current projects. This year, PAC is focusing on ways that the parish can better and more fully serve others in both a practical and a spiritual sense, including through its current ministries, through new volunteer ("Good Samaritan") efforts, and by improving the ways we can connect those we serve with the right information and assistance. Work is now underway to recommend "best practices" in each of these areas. PAC also provides and forwards observations about the parish community, serving as additional sets of "eyes and ears" on matters large and small.

PAC projects in recent years have included re-introducing the Greeters Ministry and re-vitalizing the Ushers Ministry to improve the Sunday mass experience, initiating the Father's Day Brunch this past June, and suggesting improvements for the Youth Ministry, among others.

I applied to join PAC at the suggestion of a former member, and I'm glad I did. It is a blessing to be part of a hard-working group of people who have so many talents, and to work with Fr. Alfonse in helping the parish carry out the Lord's work of mission and serving others.

QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION (QCD)





2019 YEAR END GIVING

As the calendar year end approaches, we would like to offer reminders regarding Internal Revenue Service regulations surrounding gifts to All Saints during the month of December.

Consistent with IRS regulations, all year end gifts must be postmarked by the Post Office with a 2019 date to be recorded as a gift in 2019.

THE POSTMARK ON THE ENVELOPE DETERMINES THE YEAR THE GIFT IS RECORDED

Examples for clarification are listed below:

- If All Saints receives a gift with a check dated 12/31/2019 on 1/2/2020 (or later), but the postmark on the envelope reads 12/31/2019 (or earlier) then All Saints will post the date of the gift as 12/31/2019.
- If All Saints receives a gift with a check dated 12/31/2019, but the postmark of the envelope reads 1/1/2020 (or later) then it will be posted as a gift received in 2020.

All Saints will also record all hand delivered gifts received at the All Saints Pastoral Offices on **Monday, December 30, 2019 by noon** as a 2019 gift. We are located at 5231 Meadowcreek Dr., Dallas, TX 75248 and can be reached at 972-661-9282.

Contributions charged on a donor's bank credit card are only deductible in the year the charge is made. If a donor wants to make a gift by credit card for 2019 they must make their contribution through Elexio (All Saints' secure online giving tool) by December 31, 2019.


