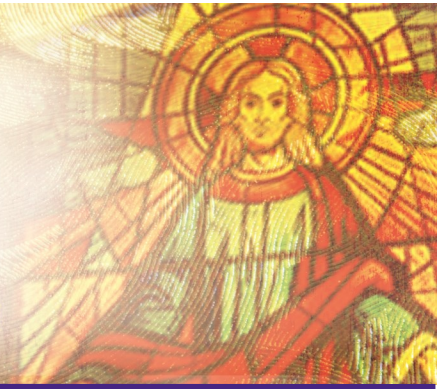

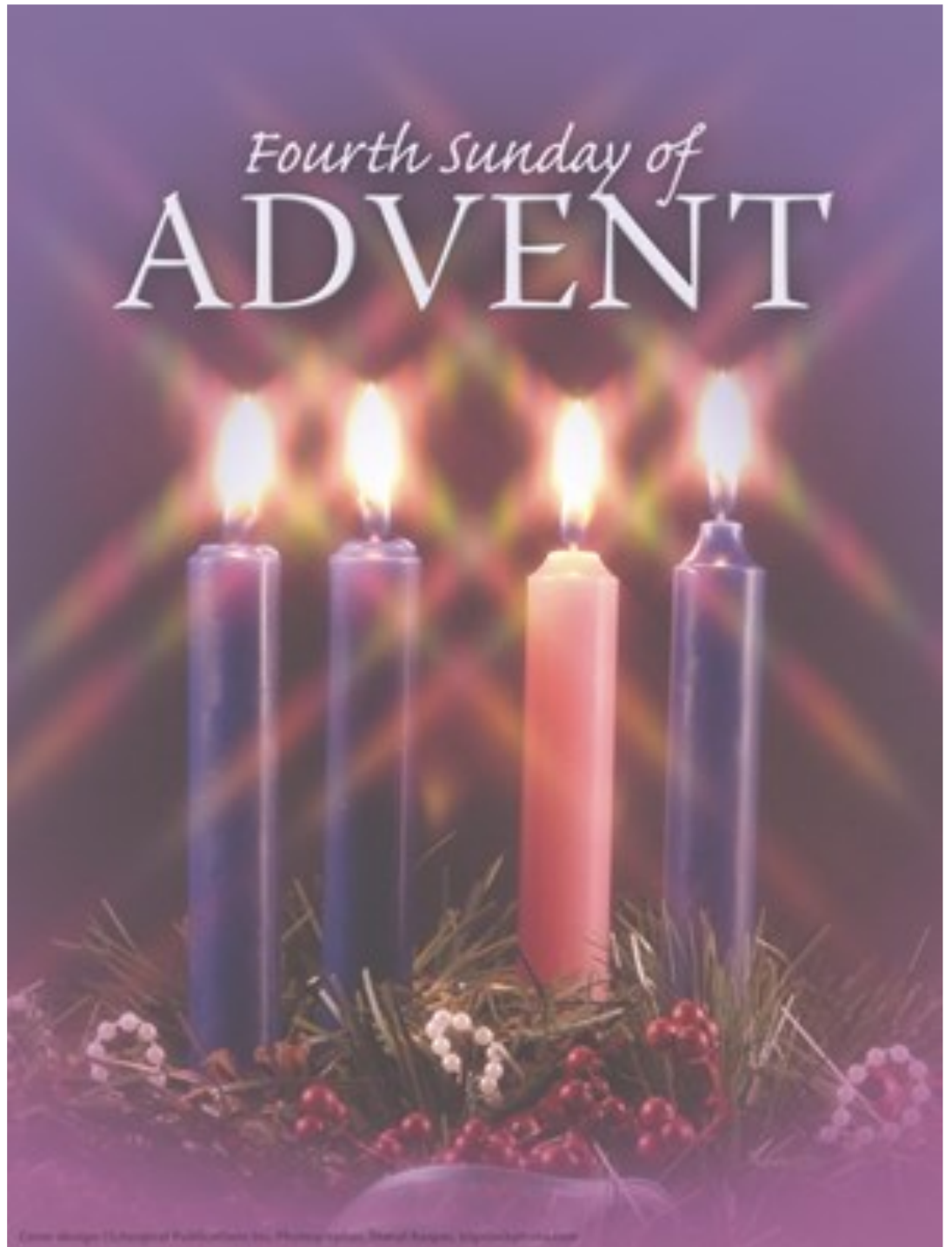

FROM THE DESK OF FR. ALFONSE...



In this fourth Sunday of Advent, we begin to witness those remarkable events that took place in our world and shook it to its rotten core. The world needed a burst of love and compassion. The Lord gave to us a love beyond all imagining.

Seek the Lord who continues to surprise. The Lord loves a surprise. His words are paradoxes that bring hidden truths to light. His words are a lamp for my feet. Mary was

surprised. Joseph was surprised. The world was surprised. Could it be? Could God truly love us this much? The facts speak for themselves. Here we are, two thousand years later and we are still celebrating the birth of our Lord. Advent is full of beautiful surprises and great expectations. First, we celebrate the arrival of the infant child. Then, we celebrate the possibility of the second coming of the Lord. But most of all, I await with great anticipation the personal coming of the Lord into my life. Yes, Heaven to earth was not the impossible journey; that was the easiest. The most difficult journey the Lord must travel is from Heaven to my heart. He was successful in entering Joseph's heart through a dream. He came into Mary's heart from an angel. And now the Lord wishes to come into my life through the Sacraments. Have I received the Lord today? Have I gone to Confession? The Lord eagerly awaits a room in my heart. Give the Lord what he most desires: a place to rest, a place to work, a place to make holy.

Seek the Lord that makes all things new. It was Joseph's intentions to divorce Mary quietly - to conceal her shame. That was the best that Joseph could do. However, the Lord had other

plans. How many times has the Lord changed your plans? Is your life what you expected it to be when you were a child? Mine sure isn't! I never expected this type of life in a million years!!! The Lord seeks to make all things new, especially our plans. How does the Lord make straight the path? By simply placing the right (or wrong) people in my life; by hiring me in this or that job; by driving or inviting his Divine Will into my life. Joseph thought he was doing Mary a favor. Instead, the Lord was doing both Mary and Joseph a favor. He invited both of them into his divine plan. Do you realize that you are a part of Salvation History? Once upon a time, someone in your family tree took a giant leap of faith and became a Roman Catholic Christian. It may have been last Easter or it may have been 1500 Easters ago. Regardless, someone took the giant leap of faith and embraced the giant faith and Sacraments we take so much for granted. Your decisions hold consequences that go far beyond our comprehension. I am or am not a Catholic because of someone's decision before me. Allow the Lord to do great things through you. Be a LOVE GIFT to the world. Someone is waiting for it. Someone is dying to receive it. Someone is in need of it. Here I am, Lord. Send me into their world!

Seek the Lord that makes straight the path. How do I make the road straight again, especially after so many years? Easy. The Lord is near to us, especially in the Sacraments. Go and receive Him. This will make the path straight again. Give the Lord the final word. Give the Lord the victory. Allow the Lord to be with you, with us. "Do not be afraid" is repeated over 366 times. One for every day, including leap year! All things, all difficulties, all trials and tribulations, all misunderstandings will find a happy ending when we allow the Lord to come and stay with us.

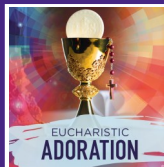

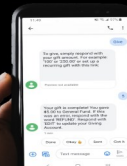

IT'S COLD & FLU SEASON

This time of year is often called "flu season." In the United States, flu viruses are most common during the fall and winter months. Influenza activity often increases in November. Most of the time flu activity peaks between December and February, and it can last as late as May.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention recommends people seek out and receive the flu vaccine. The flu vaccine is recommended for everyone six months of age and older, including pregnant women.

STOP THE SPREAD OF THE FLU

- Avoid close contact with sick people and conversely while sick, limit contact with others to keep from infecting them.
- If you are sick with flu symptoms, CDC recommends that you stay home for at least 24 hours after your fever is gone except to get medical care.
- Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.
- Wash your hands often with soap & water or use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose & mouth. Germs spread this way.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated.

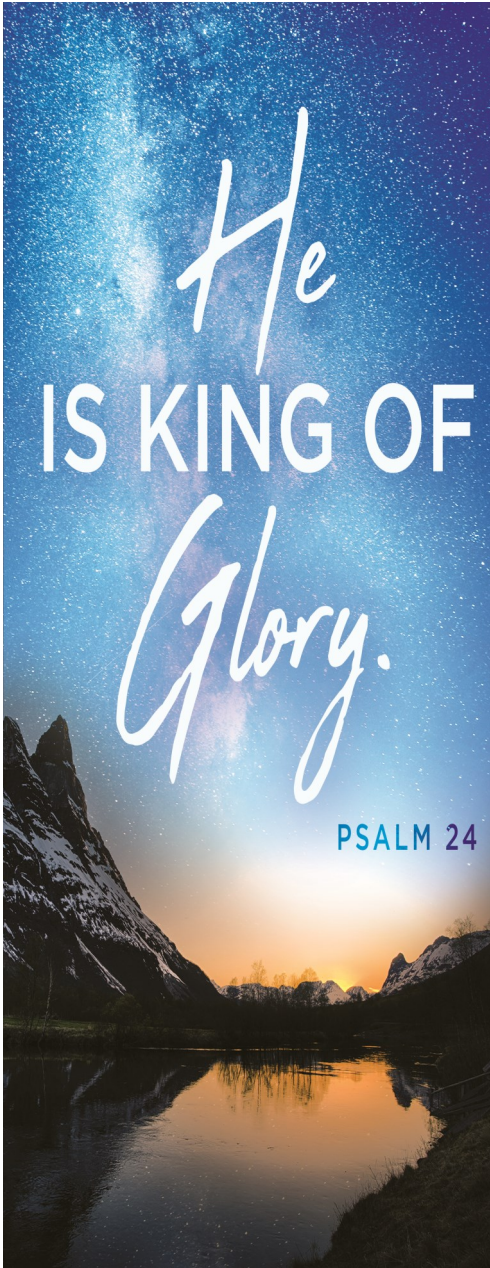

2019 YEAR END GIVING

As the calendar year end approaches, we would like to offer reminders regarding Internal Revenue Service regulations surrounding gifts to All Saints during the month of December.

Consistent with IRS regulations, all year end gifts must be postmarked by the Post Office with a 2019 date to be recorded as a gift in 2019.

THE POSTMARK ON THE ENVELOPE DETERMINES THE YEAR THE GIFT IS RECORDED

Examples for clarification are listed below:

- If All Saints receives a gift with a check dated 12/31/2019 on 1/2/2020 (or later), but the postmark on the envelope reads 12/31/2019 (or earlier) then All Saints will post the date of the gift as 12/31/2019.
- If All Saints receives a gift with a check dated 12/31/2019, but the postmark of the envelope reads 1/1/2020 (or later) then it will be posted as a gift received in 2020.

All Saints will also record all hand delivered gifts received at the All Saints Pastoral Offices on **Monday, December 30, 2019 by noon** as a 2019 gift. We are located at 5231 Meadowcreek Dr., Dallas, TX 75248 and can be reached at 972-661-9282.

Contributions charged on a donor's bank credit card are only deductible in the year the charge is made. If a donor wants to make a gift by credit card for 2019 they must make their contribution through Elexio (All Saints' secure online giving tool) by December 31, 2019.

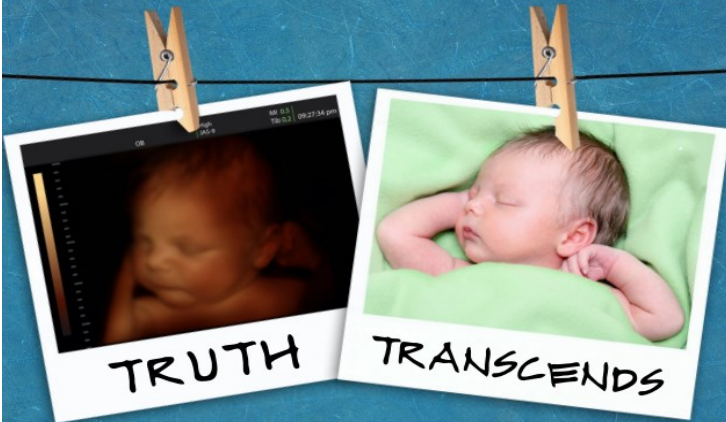
