How to apply for financial aid

Complete the FACTS online application for Grant and Aid (suggested due date April 1st for first time applicants).

Supporting Documents Needed

Please be prepared to upload the following supporting documents

Copies of your most current IRS Federal Form 1040, 1040A or 1040EZ U.S. Individual Income Tax Return (2 pages).

All supporting tax schedules C or C-EZ, Schedule E, Schedule F, Depreciation Form 4562.

If applicant and co-applicant file separately, both tax returns for the same year will be required.

Copies of your most recent W-2 forms

Household copies of Social Security Income, Welfare, Child Support, Food Stamps, Worker's Compensation, and Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF).

Processing Details

Please allow 3-4 weeks for processing. If you have provided an email address make sure to check the primary email address regularly for Notices sent by FACTS indicating missing information or tax documents.
